Scheme & Syllabus for the post of Fireman:

The sequence of tests for direct recruitment to the post of Fireman will be as follows:

- i) Written Test
- ii) Measurement of Physical Standard(as specified at b(iii) above)
- iii) Endurance Test: As specified at b(iii) above.

After the written test the number of candidates to be called on the basis of merit for measurement of physical standards test and endurance test shall be in the ratio of 1:10 i.e. 10 times the number of vacancies. For the candidates called after written test the measurement of physical standards will be carried out first. Then only those candidates who qualify in the measurement of physical standards shall be subjected to the endurance test. The measurement of physical standards test & endurance test are of qualifying nature only. Failure in any of these tests shall be failure in the examination. Candidates will be recommended for selection on the basis of their marks or merit in the written examination only.

- (i) **General Intelligence**:-The questions will be of 10th standard and would include both verbal and non verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualisation, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship concepts, figure classification, arithmetical number series, verbal and non-verbal series and Mathematics of 10th standard. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, mathematical computation and other analytical functions.
- (ii) **General Awareness**:-The Questions will be of 10th standard. Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observations and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of a 10th standard educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that, they do not require a special study of any discipline.

Questions are also designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of every day observation and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Policy and Scientific Research.

Note-01: The questions will be of the level to commensurate with Educational Qualification prescribed for the post i.e. 12th Standard.

Note-02: Resolution of tie cases(Tie cases i.e. more than one candidate secure equal marks in the written examination, the same will be resolved by applying one after another, as applicable till the Tie is resolved).

Scheme of Examination: The sequence of Tests will be as follows:

- a) Written test

- c) Screening Test of 100 meters running in 15 seconds.

After the written test, the number of candidates to be called on the basis of merit for physical test and screening test of 100 meters running in 15 seconds shall be in the ratio of 1:10 i.e. 10 times the number of vacancies. The physical test & Screening test are only of qualifying nature but failure in these tests shall be failure in the examination

- (i) **General Intelligence**: The questions will be of 10th standard and would include questions of non verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualisation, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship concepts, figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.
- (ii) **General Awareness**: – The Questions will be of 10th standard. Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observations and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of a 10th standard educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that, they do not require a special study of any discipline.
- (iii) **English Language**:- These questions will be of 10th standard, Candidate's understanding of the basics of English language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc. and writing ability would be tested.
- (iv) **Numerical Aptitude**: This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and Relationship between Numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, use of Tables and Graphs, Mensuration

Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and Work etc. The questions will be of 10th standard.

Final Grading will be decided based on marks obtained in written test subject to qualifying in the measurement of physical standards & Screening Test.

UPPER AGE RELAXATION:

- (i) Upper age relaxation upto 05 years will be given to SC/ST candidates and upto 03 years for OBC candidates. For OBC candidates upper age relaxation will be given upto 03 years only on production of OBC certificate with "Non-Creamy Layer clause".
- (ii) However, the upper age relaxation will be given only in case of posts reserved for such categories.
- (iii) Departmental candidates will get upper age relaxation as per Govt of India rules and instructions issued from time to time.
- (iv) Ex-servicemen having a minimum of six months continuous service are allowed age relaxation in upper age to the extent of the period spent in defence services plus 3 years on production of discharge certificate issued by the Competent Authority or relaxation in upper age will be granted as per latest Government of India instructions, irrespective of the fact whether the post is reserved for them or not. However, further relaxation of 05 years to SC/ST and 03 years to OBC will be given only in case of posts reserved for such categories.
- (v) Candidates with physical disability will get a relaxation of 10 years on production of a certificate from Competent Authority irrespective of the fact whether the post is reserved for them or not. In case of PWDs belonging to SC/ST further relaxation of 05 years and if belonging to OBC further relaxation of 03 years will be given only in case of posts reserved for such categories (i.e. SC/ST/OBC).
- (vi) PWDs having 40% or above disability are only eligible for fee concession, age relaxation, reservation as applicable.

APPLICATION FEE:

Candidates must send application fee in the form of crossed Indian Postal Order of Rs.50/- or Account Payee Demand Draft drawn in favour of General Manager, Ordnance Factory, Badmal for Rs.50/-(Rupees fifty only). The demand draft should be payable at State Bank of India, Badmal(code 8703). The postal order /demand draft should bear the date of issue after the date of publication of the advertisement. The issuing date of postal order should be indicated properly. The examination fee is **not refundable** under any circumstances. However, the application fee is exempted for Ex-Serviceman, Persons with Disability and candidates belonging to SC/ST categories.

CANDIDATES FROM GOVT DEPARTMENTS:

Candidate already in service in Central Govt. department/State govt. department/Semi Govt. department must submit application through proper channel. **Departmental candidates should** submit a certificate from Head of Office/Establishment that no vigilance or disciplinary case is pending nor contemplated and must also enclose a certificate from the Establishment concerned that in case of selection, their Establishment shall release them immediately while forwarding the application form within the specified date only.

RELAXATION OF STANDARD FOR RESERVED CATEGORY: Relaxation of standards in selection against reserved vacancies- if sufficient numbers of SC/ST/OBC/Ex-Serviceman/PWDs persons are not available on the basis of general standard to fill all the vacancies reserved for them, candidates belonging to these categories may be selected under the relaxed standard of selection to make up the deficiency in the reserved quota.

REJECTION OF APPLICATION: An application will be rejected if (i) found unsigned or without thumb impression (ii) Applications received with over writing/cutting beyond recognition (iii) all required documents are not found enclosed (iv) found not conforming to the required specifications (v) applications found sent through FAX (vi) application received after the due date.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS:

- a) It may also be noted that the number of above notified vacancies are subject to variation, if any, depending upon the orders of any Court/CAT in any pending case or Ordnance Factory Board/Ministry of Defence. The General Manager reserves the right to increase/decrease the number of vacancies depending upon the actual requirement and also upon the situation prevailing at the time of actual recruitment/induction without any notice.
- b) The post of Store Keeper is identified suitable for persons with disability having disabilities like OL, OA & LV and the post of Durwan is identified suitable for OH(OA). PWDs having 40% or above disability are eligible for fee concession, age relaxation, reservation whatsoever. PWD candidates should also enclose Disability certificate issued by Competent Authority.

- c) SC/ST/OBC certificate should be issued by Competent Authority and should be in the prescribed format applicable for reservation in jobs under Govt of India. OBC candidates must submit latest caste certificate in the prescribed format applicable specifically including the clause regarding "Non-Creamy Layer" and should be valid at the relevant point of time i.e. the last of date of receipt of application. Ex-Serviceman candidates should enclose copy of discharge certificate issued from Military service.
- d) The services of persons appointed are liable to be transferred to any Ordnance and Ordnance Equipment Factories in India.
- e) The selected candidate will be governed by "NEW DEFINED CONTRIBUTION PENSION SCHEME."
- f) Copies of relevant certificates showing age and educational qualification, Marks sheets, Caste certificate (wherever applicable), other testimonials wherever required must be attached along with the application form. All documents should be attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- g) For date of birth, only High School(10th standard) or equivalent certificate will be accepted.
- h) The Ordnance Factory, Badmal management will not be held responsible for late/non-receipt of call letters for written examination/test due to delay in postal channel.
- i) Only selected candidate would be informed of their selection in due course after the selection process and no correspondence on the subject would be entertained.
- j) All the information furnished in the application must be supported by relevant documents duly attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- k) Envelope containing the application form must be super scribed as APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF _____. Applications may be rejected if not superscribed as above. The applicant should also indicate the name of the state to which he/she belongs on the top right hand corner of the envelope.
- l) The applicant should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria, regarding educational qualification, age and caste and other requirements.
- m) Particulars furnished in the application forms should be correct in all respect. If any false/incorrect information furnished by the Applicant is detected at any stage, his candidature will be cancelled without prejudice to taking legal action against him.
- n) No travelling allowance will be paid to the candidates (Except SC/ST candidates) for appearing in the written examination/Skill Test. However, for SC/ST candidates, travelling allowance, only second class fare for to and fro journey shall be reimbursed as per Rules on production of journey details including Railway/Bus tickets by the shortest route.

- o) All applicants must enclose three colour passport size recent (not more than three months old) photographs. Three photographs should be same and should not differ with each other. Out of three photographs two photographs should be duly attested by a Gazetted Officer and stapled with the application form and one photograph is to be pasted in the space provided in the application form and duly self signed in the front of the photograph in such a manner that signature is partly on application form and partly on the photograph. Attestation by Gazetted officer should be done on the back side of the photograph.
- p) The General Manager/Ordnance Factory Badmal reserves the right to modify/alter/restrict/cancel the recruitment process due to any directives of Court/CAT case or as per instructions from Ordnance Factory Board/Ministry of Defence, without issuing any further notice or assigning any reason thereafter. The decision of GM/OFBL will be final and no appeal will be entertained against this issue.
