B. Skill Test: 50 Marks

Only those candidates who attain a minimum- qualifying standard of 40% in the written examination will be eligible to be called for skill test. General Awareness —Questions are designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions are also designed to test the knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General polity and scientific research.

General Intelligence- The questions will be of 10th standard and would include both verbal and non-verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgement, decision making, visual memory, discrimination observation, relationship concept, figure classification, arithmetical number series, verbal and non-verbal series & mathematics of 10th standard. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, mathematical computation and other analytical functions.

General Awareness –The questions will be of 10th standard.
