  - (c) Relaxation for Ex-Serviceman in accordance with the orders or instructions issued by the Government from time-to-time.

- 1. Persons who have represented State or the Country in the National or International competition in any of the Games/Sports listed below.
- 2. Persons who have represented their University in the Inter-University Tournaments conducted by the Inter-University Sports Board in any of these Games.
- 3. Persons who have represented the State School Teams in the National Sports/Games conducted by the All India School Games Federation in any of these Games/Sports.
- 4. Persons who have been awarded National Awards in Physical Efficiency under National Physical Efficiency Drive.

The candidates possessing the above mentioned qualifications as on 4. 31.01.2014 and possessing 15 years Residence Certificate issued by the Competent Authority may apply to the Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Panaji in the prescribed Application Form. The prescribed Application Forms are available at Goa Police Welfare Cell, GRP Administrative Block, GRP Camp, Altinho, Panaji, which can be collected between 09.30 hrs. to 17.30 hrs. on all working days on payment of ` 20/- per Form. The Application Forms completed in all respects should reach the Office of the Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Panaji on or before 31.01.2014. Incomplete Application Forms, Application Forms received after 31.01.2014 and Applications not in prescribed Form will be summarily rejected and no intimation will be sent to the applicants in this regard. Candidates should minutely go through all the provisions in the advertisement to ensure that he/she is eligible for the post of Police Constable in terms of requirement of age, educational qualification etc. and only eligible candidates may apply in the prescribed Application Form.

5. In case Application Forms are sent by post, they should reach the Office of the Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Panaji on or before 31.01.2014. The Police Department will not be responsible for postal delay and the Application Forms received after 31.01.2014 will be summarily rejected and no intimation will be sent to the applicants in this regard.

6. The candidates working in Government Departments/Offices should apply through proper channel in prescribed Application Forms only. These Application Forms should also reach the Office of the Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Panaji on or before 31.01.2014. Application Forms received after 31.01.2014 will be summarily rejected and no intimation will be sent to the applicants in this regard.

7. No certificates/documents are required to be attached with Application Form by the candidate. During the selection process, verification of original certificates/documents will be done. The candidates will have to produce requisite original certificates/documents such as Birth Certificate, Educational Qualification Certificates, 15 years Residence Certificate, Caste Certificate etc. before the Recruitment Boards. Original certificates/documents will be checked and only eligible candidates will be permitted to the next stage of recruitment process i.e. Physical Measurements and if qualified in both, for Physical Efficiency Test as mentioned above to be conducted by the Police Department. Candidates who fail to produce the requisite certificates/documents will be eliminated from the recruitment process and in no case candidates will be allowed provisionally.

8. During the Physical Measurements, the candidates who are not satisfied with the decision of the Physical Measurement Boards regarding their height, weight and chest measurements, they can appeal immediately before the Appeal Board in prescribed Appeal Form available with the Appeal Board.

9. The Physical Efficiency Test (PET) is a qualifying test. A candidate must qualify in all the events of Physical Efficiency Test mentioned above. It is clarified that as per the High Jump Rules, the candidate should take off from one foot and as such, the Jump on two feet (Dolphin Jump) will not be allowed. The candidate who fails in any event will be rejected at that stage only and will not be allowed to appear in the remaining events. There shall be no Appeals against disqualification in Runs, Jumps and Throws. The Police Department will not be responsible for any compensation or claim due to accident/injury/damage, if any, sustained during the course of the recruitment tests. The decision of the Recruitment Boards shall be final in the conduct of the recruitment.

10. The candidates who qualify in the Physical Efficiency Test will be subjected to Written Examination of Secondary School Certificate Examination level. The Written Examination shall be of 85 marks. The distribution of these 85 marks shall be (i) General Knowledge - 25 marks (ii) General English - 25 marks (iii) Maths - 20 marks and (iv) Essay - 15 marks. Minimum passing marks in the Written Examination shall be 35%. No representation for re-evaluation of Written Examination of Written Examination will be entertained.

11. The candidates who pass in Written Examination will be called for Oral Interview which shall be of 15 marks.

12. The decision of the Police Department with regard to the matters connected with the recruitment will be final in all respects and the Police Department has full right to make changes or to cancel the recruitment process without assigning any reasons.

13. The selected candidates will have to undergo prescribed training for specific period at any place of training.
